CivicSpark Fellows are emerging leaders selected through a competitive national interview process. All Fellows have a passion for community-driven change, at minimum an associate's degree, and workplace and community service experience.

All projects serve communities with significant needs such as environmental or social burdens, or lacking action plans or staff resources to address community resilience needs.
